Procedure for New Student Enrollment

STEP 1: Learn about King's Valley Christian School: Schedule a tour, visit our website, call our office, read our parent handbook, and speak with our current parents!

STEP 2: Fill out the application and turn it in to the school office. All parents with legal custody of the child must sign the application. The application must be accompanied by a check for both the non-refundable registration fee and the academic assessment fee.

STEP 3: Schedule an academic assessment and a parent interview. (~2 hours) Bring the following to the academic assessment:

- a. Copies of student report cards from the previous 2 years
- b. Copies of assessment data from the previous 2 years (SATs, Star Testing, etc.)
- c. Completed, confidential teacher recommendation form

Within seven business days of the academic assessment, you will receive a letter stating the administration's decision regarding the enrollment of your student. If your student is accepted, the following information will be required:

- ♦ Up-to-date immunization record.
- ♦ Signed probationary form.
- ♦ Completed emergency form

Please note that all kindergarten students must be five years old on or before September 1. A photocopy of the certified birth certificate must be provided. Also, all kindergarten and first grade students must have a completed "REPORT OF HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR SCHOOL ENTRY" form on file by December 1.

KVCS seeks to enroll students without regard to race, color, or ethnic origin.

Philosophy Statement
